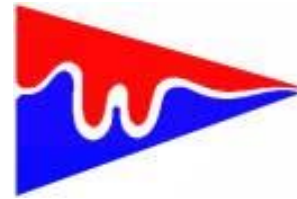

GOOD NEWS!

Due to protest by U.S. boaters and other groups including private aircraft pilots, commercial fisherman and BoatUS, the FY2007 appropriation bill or DHS was recently signed into law. It will provide the funds necessary for LORAN to continue to be maintained and operated. Loran has been shown to be a low-cost, ground-based and jam-proof backup for GPS. There is also the potential for "e-LORAN" receivers which combine the best features of both the LORAN and GPS systems into very accurate and reliable units.

Discontinuation of *CG on Cell Phone

The Coast Guard has requested that the cellular companies reroute all *CG calls to the 911 Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP) nearest to where the call originated. As an added precaution, mariners should stop using the special keying sequence *CG and begin using 911 on their cell phones to notify authorities of a distress at the onset of a maritime emergency if a cell phone is their only means of communication.

121.5/243 MHZ EPIRBs Discontinued

BOATERS MUST NOT OPERATE 121.5/243 MHZ EPIRBs AFTER 31 DECEMBER 2006. The Coast Guard reminds all boaters that beginning January 1, 2007, both 121.5 and 243 MHz Emergency Position Indicating Radio Beacons (EPIRBs) are prohibited from use in both commercial and recreational watercraft. Boaters wishing to have an emergency rescue beacon aboard their vessel must have a digital 406 MHz model.

The January 1, 2007, date to stop using 121.5 MHz EPIRBs is in preparation for February 1, 2009, when satellite processing of distress signals from all 121.5/243 MHz beacons will terminate. Following this termination date, only the 406 MHz beacons will be detected by the International Cospas-Sarsat Satellite System which provides distress alert and location data for search and rescue operations around the world.

The regulation applies to all Class A, B, and S 121.5/243 MHz EPIRBs. It does not affect 121.5/243 MHz man overboard devices which are designed to work directly with a base alerting unit only and not with the satellite system.

"National Safe Boating Week" May 20th – 26th

VSC's are offered by experienced members of the U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary and the United States Power Squadrons®, two of the nation's premier volunteer boating safety organizations. A VSC is your best way of learning about problems that might put you in violation of state or federal laws or, worse, create danger for you or your passengers on the water.

Coast Guard & Auxiliary votes for Mandatory Boating Education.

The U.S.C.G. and their Auxiliary are encouraging state legislatures to pass mandatory boater education laws in their respective states. They are also suggesting mandatory operator licensing for boaters.

The Marine Retailers Association of America is opposing this type of mandate. MRAA argues that other efforts to reduce boating fatalities are working and to impose a licensing program would be an unfunded mandate that is both unfair and a violation of states rights. MRA does suggest that dealers encourage boat operator education.
