Money coming to the Black River in Lorain, Ohio

National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration announced that it has awarded about \$9.2 million to nine projects throughout the Great Lakes Region that will restore fish habitat by removing dams and barriers, constructing fish passage, restoring wetlands, removing marine debris and invasive species.

During 2010, President Obama announced \$475 million in new funding for his Great Lakes Restoration Initiative, the largest investment in the Great Lakes in two decades. The Initiative targets some of the most serious threats to the Great Lakes: invasive species, non-point source pollution, and contaminated sediment.

Lower Black River Fish Habitat Restoration Project (Lorain, Ohio) – \$1.7 million – The City of Lorain, Ohio will build two fish habitat shelves, totaling more than 3,000 feet of new fish habitat, in the Black River watershed – a tributary to Lake Erie.

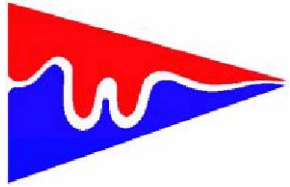

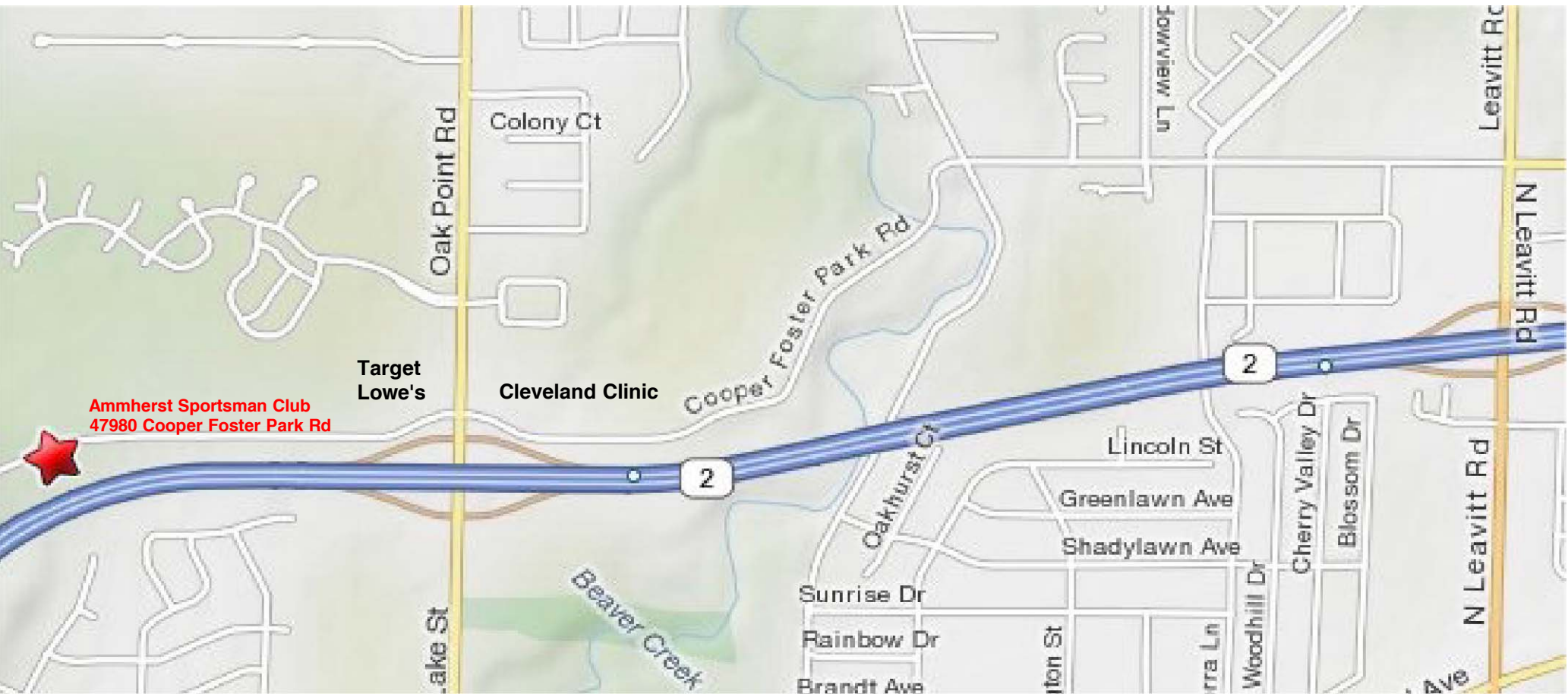
